The GRAI LGBTI ACVVS is a FREE service that aims to improve quality of life for older LGBTI people living in an aged care residential home or living in their home with support from an aged care home package.

GRAI can connect you with a younger (aged 18+) LGBTIQA+ volunteer for regular social visits.

Participants and volunteers are matched based on shared interests and hobbies.

Visits may include having a chat, going out for a cuppa or for walks, playing games or more.

When you apply for an ACVVS visitor our Coordinator will visit you to have a chat and find out more about you so we can find a suitable volunteer visitor.

The Coordinator is available to support you and your volunteer throughout your time with the program.
